

## **Autumn Leaves Supply List**

Finished Size Approx: 33" x 41"

### **Materials**

1 3/4 yards of assorted prints for leaves  
1 yard black print for border and sashing  
1 yard assorted blacks for backgrounds of leaves  
\*1/8 yard assorted prints for stem-we will discuss options for stems in class  
1/4 yard for middle border (orange in picture)  
1 1/3 yards for backing  
3/8 yard for binding

### **Supplies**

Sewing machine in good working order  
Surge protector for machine  
Basic sewing supplies  
Seam Ripper  
Scissors  
Straight Pins  
12" 'Add A Quarter Ruler' – nice to have  
Rotary Cutter  
Cutting Mat  
Ruler: 18" length is fine  
Small pressing board & iron  
Size 90 machine needle  
Piecing thread  
Foundation Paper or Photo Copy paper for pattern – make copies of pattern before class.

Pattern: A Piedmont Fall - available at Randy's Quilt Shop

### **Before Class Preparation:**

Make copies of at least 2 each of the Small & Medium leaves (make sure to copy both A & B parts for each leaf). Copy onto foundation paper or photo copy paper (foundation paper is easier to tear away: Easy Paper Foundation or Carol Doaks' Foundation Paper both work well.)

From assorted prints for leaves cut:

12 strips: 2.75" x 42" - This gives you an extra 1/4" width more than needed, however, you can cut 3" x 42" strips if you prefer.

For leaf backgrounds - Black Prints cut: (This is just to get you started; you will be cutting more strips later.)

3 strips: 2 1/2" x 42"

3 strips: 3 1/4" x 42"
